

Welcome to Tanager Boat Club!

We are located just 800 metres from Tananger centre, where you will find food and clothes shops, a hardware store, hairdressers, and lots more.

Tananger's inner harbour has historic maritime traditions. Famous as an old pilots' base, the harbour has been a centre for the trade and export of lobster and herring for generations, and it is still possible to buy fish and shellfish from local fishing boats. You will find a coastal culture centre with historic boats, equipment and an ocean of information about the history of Tananger.

The harbour offers a slipway with a weight limit of 10 tonnes.

ALL-YEAR HARBOUR

The mooring fees for guest boats are NOK 150 per day (up to 40 foot), and NOK 200 per day (over 40 foot). For longer stays, fees will be by arrangement.

- Petrol is not available in the harbour itself. There is an 800 metre walk to the nearest petrol station
